### Important Entry Information

Please note that in order to comply with the requirements of our Level 2 License, **entries for this meet must be within (ie equal to or faster than) the published qualifying times** for each event.

These entries will be accepted on a **first come first served basis**.

In certain circumstances however, the promoters still reserve the right to restrict the number of entries by rejecting entries. (See Meet Rules and Information, particularly **rule 8**, for full details).

### Competition for All and Meet Licensing

In order to try and provide "*quality competition*" at all levels, the ASA operate a system of "**Meet Licensing**". Licenses are granted at different "**Levels**" (Levels 1, 2, 3 and 4). There is a requirement for Licensed Meets to have entry "**Qualifying**" times. Level 3 Licensed Meets also have "**Upper Limit Cut Off**" times as well. By the correct application of these Qualifying and Cut Off times, Licensed Meets at the different levels become available for entry to swimmers of the appropriate ability.

There have been significant changes to meet licensing introduced in September 2009 whereby Level 1 meets are now only Long Course and Level 2 meets only Short Course, but with minimum qualifying standards similar to the equivalent for Level 1 meets.
