CLOSING DATE FOR RECEIPT OF ENTRIES FOR ALL EVENTS - 22nd January 2010

ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION

All entrants must be eligible competitors as defined by ASA Law and must be registered with the ASA on the closing date in the name of the club under which they wish to enter. That club must be directly affiliated to Derbyshire ASA. No competitor shall swim in any other County's championships/competitions in 2010. There will be registration checks.

AGES FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

All ages are as at 21st March 2010 juniors are defined as under 17 years on 21st March 2010 There are single year age groups for ages 9-16, a combined age group 17-19 and a 20 & over age group. Awards will be given to the first six in each age group.

TEAM SWIMMING

All members of a club relay team must comply with the eligibility and registration requirement above but need not have entered an individual event. Team entries shall be made on 2010 Team Entry Forms. A club may enter more than one team per event. Team Managers must inform the Recorders of the names and swimming order of all relay events.

GALAS 16 & 17.

The relays in Galas 16 & 17 are to assist clubs intending to send teams to the Regional Age Group and Youth relay events. The age at day for these events is the same as will be used at the 2010 Nationals August 1st 2010 for the National Age Group and August 7th 2010 for the National Youth events. Except for the events where you are swimming for the Ken Miller Trophy (mixed 200m Freestyle relay), which is age as of 31st December 2010.

ENTRY FOR AGE GROUP EVENTS.

All events will be swum with seeded heats. Entry times, converted if necessary to a 25m pool, must have been achieved after 1 May 2009 and be certified by signing the entry form. All entry times must have been achieved at a competition or time trials and be equal to or faster than the minimum standards published separately.

SWIMMERS WITH BIRTH DATES BETWEEN 22nd MARCH and 2nd AUGUST

Those swimmers who by virtue of their date of birth change age groups at Regional or National events and thereby have additional entries available at those events may be allowed to swim the additional events as a time trial. This concession will be considered by the promoter on receipt of an entry time and written request submitted by the club coach of the swimmer concerned. The results will not be included in the swimmers points total. The normal event fee will be charged.

COMBINED EVENTS

Where Age Group events are to be swum combined with Championship events, swimmers taking part will be considered as competing for all eligible titles. Only one entry fee per combined event is required. To be eligible for the championship trophy a swimmer must achieve the qualifying time for the open or junior age group during the event to receive an award.

FINALS & HEAT DECLARED WINNERS

All individual events will be swum as heats only with Declared Winners. All heats in the competition will be spearheaded.

AGE GROUPS (9 – 14 Men, 9 – 13 Women)

Points will be calculated for each swim. These will be aggregated according to the ASA CDC proposals and awards given to the top 3 swimmers in each age group category. Awards will also be made to the first three in each stroke and age group.

YOUTH (15-19 Men, 14-19 Women), 20+ and JUNIOR/OPEN

Awards will be made to the first three in each stroke and age group providing there are 4 or more swimmers competing otherwise awards will be on the basis of number of swimmers minus one. Awards for Junior and Open events are subject to achieving the qualifying time as specified earlier.

COMPETITOR REPORTING

Secondary entry cards will not be used. Competitors may withdraw up to 1 hour before the scheduled start of the session by telephoning 07929 377809 and leaving a message stating swimmers name, gala, event number and competitor number.

FINES FOR LATE WITHDRAWAL OR NO-SHOW

Late withdrawals and no-shows will result in a £5 fine per swim, payable by the club under whose name the swimmer has entered the competition. Non-payment of the fine will result in the swimmer being prevented from entry to any other competition promoted by Derbyshire ASA until the fine has been paid.

FEES & ENTRIES (Cheques payable to Derbyshire ASA)

All individual events - £4.50 per event. Team events - £8.00 per event. These should be sent, as soon as possible, on the official 2010 INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FORM or 2010 TEAM ENTRY FORM to Mrs. J. Mellor, 20 Atlow Road, Chaddesden, Derby. DE21 6JG together with the correct entry fee. For individual events only one block form will be accepted from each swimmer. Please note the single closing date above. Details of all accepted entries will be posted on the Derbyshire ASA Web site (www.derbyshireswimming.org.uk) on 1st February 2010. Errors must be reported to the Promoter by 12th February 2010 (email: comp@derbyshireswimming.org.uk).

All entries should be submitted through the swimmers club. The method of submission of entries is by the "Sportsystems" entry program, which is available for all clubs.

Please note there will be a surcharge for manual entries of £10.00 per club

ASA LICENSE

This competition is licensed by the ASA for entry into National and Regional Championships.

OTHER SWIMMING EVENTS

The 2010 Long Course Competition will be held on 12th December 2010 at Ponds Forge, Sheffield
